**ATTENTION EXHIBITORS OF FOREIGN DOGS**

Effective August 1, 2024 the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) is expanding requirements for the importation/entry of foreign dogs into the United States. Requirements include that all dogs must be at least 6 months of age, microchipped, complete new CDC Dog Import forms, and have a valid rabies vaccination or be able to demonstrate residence in a DMRVV (canine rabies)-free or low risk country for the last 6 months. THE AMATEUR-OWNER-HANDLER CLASS shall be for dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog. This class is restricted to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional dog handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13).

#### **Non-Regular Classes (Involving Single Dog Entries)**

Dogs/Bitches entered in Veterans Class need not be intact. Spayed & Neutered animals are eligible. Winners of the above classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed

**BEST OF BREED COMPETITION:** The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records.

#### **JUDGE'S AWARDS OF MERIT**

All dogs, either sex, eligible for Best of Breed Competition shall be considered for these awards. At the discretion of the Intersex judge, the maximum number of Awards of Merit that may be given shall be 10% of the Best of Breed entry, including Veterans and Winners, rounding up to the next whole number. That 10% is in addition to the Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog & Select Bitch winners with no consideration as to sex. Each dog selected shall receive a Medallion on Neck Ribbon offered by the Medallion Rottweiler Club.

#### **AKC GRAND CHAMPION TITLE POINTS**

Champions of Record including Champions that are Non-Regular class winners (i.e. Veteran Class Winners) or dogs that have been "moved up" to Best of breed Competition for the show are the only dogs eligible for Grand Championship points. Although Winners Dog and Winners Bitch can win Best of Breed or Best of Opposite Sex, in no case will they be eligible for Grand Championship Competition. Grand Championship points may be awarded to Best of Breed, Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog or Select Bitch. Points will be awarded at the judge's discretion.

### **Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entries)**

**STUD DOG:** For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class. **BROOD BITCH:** Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. **NOTE:** As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

35% of total entry fee will be retained by the Club for expenses. 10% of the remainder will be divided equally between Best in Each Sweepstakes & Best of Opposite Sex to Best in Each Sweepstakes. The remainder will be divided in each class as follows:

#### **SWEEPSTAKES**

## JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

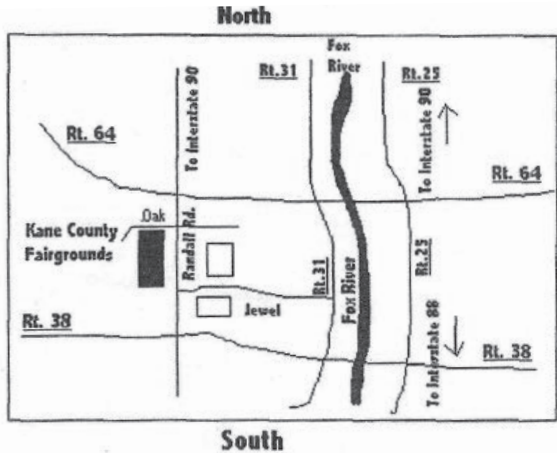

## PREFACE:

*The sport of purebred dog competitive events dates prior to 1884, the year of AKC's birth. Shared values of those involved in the sport include principles of sportsmanship. They are practiced in all sectors of our sport: conformation, performance and companion. Many believe that these principles of sportsmanship are the prime reason why our sport has thrived for over one hundred years. With the belief that it is useful to periodically articulate the fundamentals of our sport, this code is presented.*

- Sportsmen respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen commit themselves to values of fair play, honesty, courtesy, and vigorous competition, as well as winning and losing with grace.
- Sportsmen refuse to compromise their commitment and obligation to the sport of purebred dogs by injecting personal advantage or consideration into their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsman judge judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsman judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsman exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsman exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- The sportsman respects the AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies governing the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportsmen find that vigorous competition and civility are not inconsistent and are able to appreciate the merit of their competition and the effort of competitors.
- Sportsmen welcome, encourage and support newcomers to the sport.
- Sportsmen will deal fairly with all those who trade with them.
- Sportsmen are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportsmen spurn any opportunity to take personal advantage of positions offered or bestowed upon them.
- Sportsmen always consider as paramount the welfare of their dog.
- Sportsmen refuse to embarrass the sport, the American Kennel Club, or themselves while taking part in the sport.
