MEDALLION ROTTWEILER CLUB CODE OF ETHICS

TheMedallion RottweilerClub Constitution and By-Laws, Article I, Section 2, paragraphs (a), (b) and (c) states: The objective of the Club shall be:(a) to encourage and promote the breeding of pure-bred Rottweilers and to doall possible to bring tbeirnatural qualities toperfection. (b) to doall in itspower toprotect and advance the interests of the breed bymaintaining high breeding standards and by encouraging sportsman like competition at dog shows, obedience trials, tracking tests, herding and agility trials and any other American Kennel Club sanctioned events where Rottweilers are, or will be, permitted to participate. (c) to conduct sanctioned and licensed specialty shows, obcd icnce trials, tracking tests, herdingand agility trials and anyother American Kennel Club sanctioned events where Rottweilers are, or will be, permitted to participate under the care of the American Kennel Club. To elaborate on those three Constitutional statements, this Code of Ethics is drawn up and subscribed to in the section and paragraphs that follow:

I. Purpose. In Rottweiler breeding, the emphasis shall be placed upon working ability and other outstanding qualities of character of this breed, as well as upon appearance. Consistent with the aforementioned, I wiII agree to breed discriminatingly and only upon strong evidence of the possibility of finding suitable homes for the resultant puppies. Iunderstand and agree that tobreed unadvisedlymaylead tooverpopulationand contribute materially to the deterioration of the Rottweiler breed.

II. Records. I agree, if I breed my bitch or use my stud in service, tokeep accurate records of stock, matings, andpedigrees, and to register mybreeding stock with the American Kennel Club.

M. Breeding. Iagree thatonly those Rottweile.rs will be used for breeding which bave OFA (Orthopedic Foundation for Animals) certified hipx-rays(or certi tied byforeign counterparts of the OFA) and imported Rottweilers must have OFA certification within six months after arrival in U.S.A. The Board of Directors strongly recommends and suggests that all breeding stock be permanently identified byone orall of thefollowing: tattoo,microchip, DNA markers, prior to health certifications being obtained from the OFA.

Lf frozen or chilled semen is used, the dog must be x-rayed and certified by the OFA or foreign counterpart at no less than 24 months of age.

Breeding stock shall have no disqualifying fault(s) as listed in the 1990 Official AKC Standard, such as: Entropioa, ectropioa; Overshot, undershot (when incisors doaottoucb or mesh); wry mouth; twoor more missingteeth. Unilateral cryptorchid orcr:yptorchidmales. Longcoat. Any base colorother than black; absence of all markings. Excessive temperament exhibited as consistent. I will further agree tbat, should I breed from lines in which I am knowledgeable that any of the above do occur, I will disclose this to my buyers.

As the owner of a hitch: 1 will only breed nonnal healthy, mature bitches which have reached their 24th month of age. I will not permit my bitch to produce litters in three consecutive seasons. I further agree to cull deformed puppies.

As the owner of a stud dog: 1 will only breed healthy, mature dogs which have reached their 24thmonth of age. 1 will refuse stud service to any bitch who has not reached her 24th month, or which 1 consider in poor health, or which has disqualifying faults or radical departures from the 1990 official AKC Standard.

I will follow the custom to allow one repeat service (at the bitch's next season) where a bitch has failed to conceive after being bred to one of mystuds, if the stud is still in good health and available, and at such time and place as mutually agreed to by the owner of the bitch and myself.

I will encourage bitch owners tobreed only if they have the facilities, time and resources to adequately care for a litter.

It is recommended that each member make a sincere e!Ton to see that a reasonable portion of an anticipated litter by his bitch or that resulted from the use of his stud dog is suitably spoken for before a breeding takes place.

A bitch may be bred to only onestud-dog during anyone estrous cycle with the exception that a bitch may be bred to multiple sires in the same estrus cycle with strictadherence to the AKC Multiple-Sire Registration Application requirements.

Breeders andstud dogowners recognize that theyhavea lifetimeresponsibility for puppies produced by their brood bitch or studdog. Breeders mustalso recognize the their brood bitch or studdog. Breeders mustalso recognize the their protects each puppy's physical and emotional well being. This includes helping to relocate to a new home that puppy (or adult dog) which the owner is unable/unwilling to keep or taking that puppy (or adult dog) back. Any provisions for refunds or reimbursement of expenses shall be handled in the contract between the breeder and owner. No puppy or adult dog bred or owned by an MRC member shall be disposed of inan animal shelter or pound unless such disposal is required bylaw. Enforcement of this paragraph would require that both t11e breeder and the stud dog owner failed to respond to notification in writing of the plight of the dog/puppy in harm's way.

IV. Health. I agree to maintain good standards of health and care of my dogs including proper veterinary care. If urtheragree that proper mental bealth bincludes regular contact with people and exposure to the outside world.

V. <u>Sales.</u> *I* will refuse to recommend breeders who do not confonn to the obligations expressed in thisCode, ortosell todogwholesalers and retailers (such as pct shops), or to donate a Rottweiler for raffle purposes, or to sell or buy in litter-lots.

I will use a written agreement with any sales involving a dog.

I will pass on to the buyers of puppies oradult dogs accurate health breedingand registmtion records and a four generation pedigree. When appropriate, AKC limited registration procedures will be followed and the buyer will beadvised of the restrictions of this type of registration.

I will follow the general practice of breeders, that any puppy sold a a show prospect which subsequently develops a genetic disqualifying defects hall be: $\{I\}$ replaced by the breeder with another show prospect puppy, or (2) the money refunded and the dogreturned to the breeder or (3) the buyers money be refunded to the extent of the differences between the price of pet puppies sold from the same or similar litters with the buyer retaining the dog, or any other mutually agreeable alternative.

I will further recommend to my puppy purchasers that they render incapable of reproducing any dogwhich

bas developed disqualifying and serious faults thereby rendering the dog unsuitable for breeding.

I will not release puppies before they are seven weeks of age, and thenonly with the full knowledge that they are healthy and have had the required medical inoculations and care.

I will urge my puppypurchasers to provide obedience training at the proper age. As a breeder I will make a sincere effort to see that every dog wiII have an adequate home and be properly cared for.

<u>VI. Advertising.</u> I agree that myadvertising, oral or written, shall be factual and not worded so as to attract undesirable buyers, or to encourage the raising of purebred Rottweilcrs as an easy money scheme. No price should be given in advertising Rottweilers.

<u>VII. Sportsmanship</u>. I shallconduct myself at all times il1 a manner which will reflect credit upon meand the breed, regardless of the location or circumstances, but especially when attendingdogsbows, whether asan exhibitorora spectator. It is recommended that this conduct follow through at club meetings.

VIII. Enforcement. Iunderstand and agree that upon receipt of sufficient written proof of violations of this Code of Ethics, the Board of Directors will proceed according to the Constitution of the Medallion Rottweiler Club, Article VII (Discipline). A Grievance Committee of three members is to be appointed by the Board of Directors as required to report their findings to the Board for a vote by the Board.

IX. <u>Special Circumstances</u>. I further understandand agree that should J, through no fault of myown, be in violation of anyof the aforementioned provisions, Ishall have recourse to the Grievance Committee appointed by the Board of Directors.
